- Connect users directly to the shared PC via standard cables up to 10 m (33 ft) long

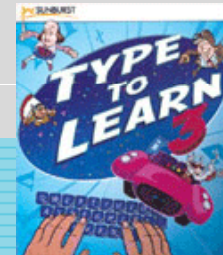
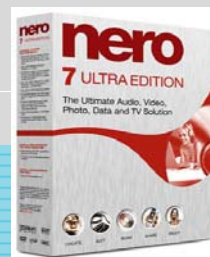


What can it Do

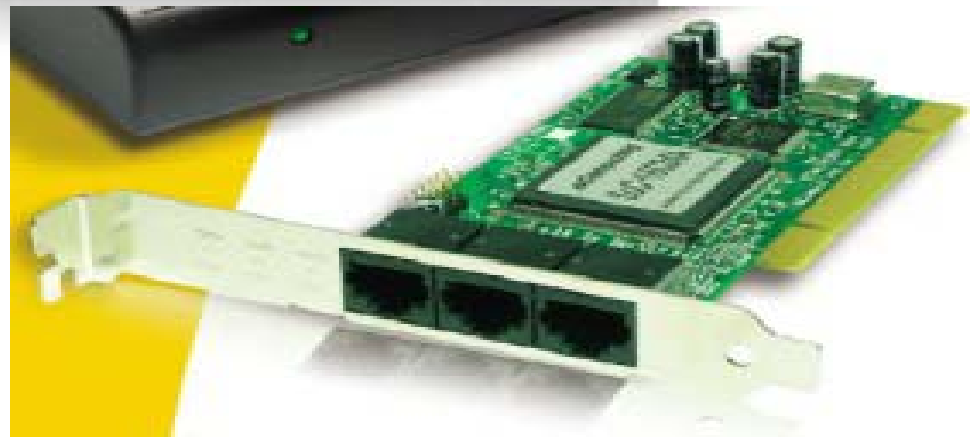

How Do I Connect my N-Computing

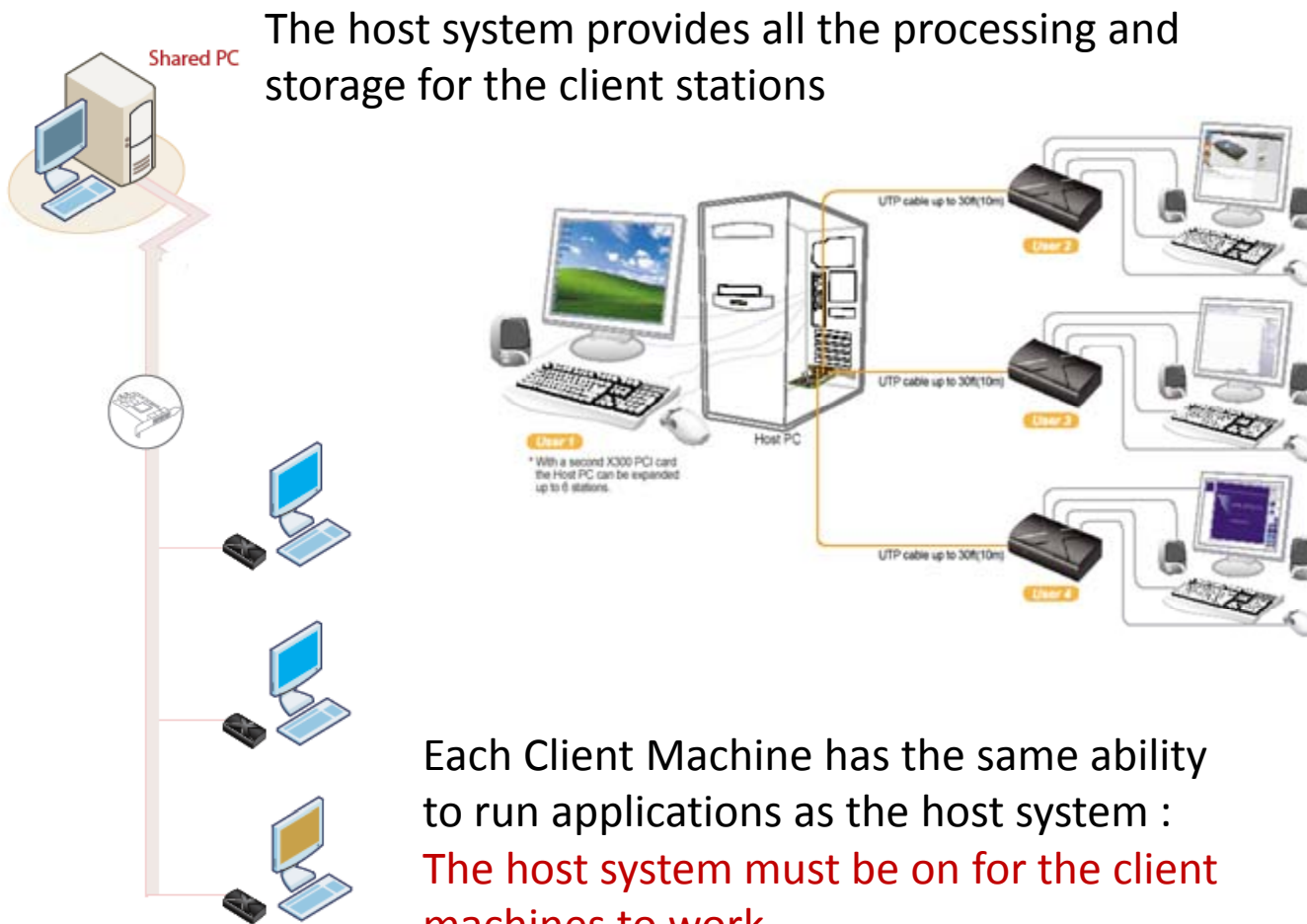


1. Speaker Port

Saving with N-Computing

The only place to permanently store information with N-Computing is to save to the My Documents folder or place files in the root of the E: drive, the My Documents folder Defaults to the E: drive. **If you store files anywhere else they will be DELETED as soon as you restart your machine**



Frequently Asked Questions

Can I as a user install software on my N-computing

No, any software that you install will be lost on restart. Contact Office of Technology if you need something added.

Why are they locked down

The lock down software is to protect the machine from harm and allow it to function like new on a day to day basis. Restart and the machine is reloaded.

Can I save to a USB Pen Drive

Yes the USB function is fully supported on the host machine, by plugging the pen drive into the host machine all clients will be able to access it.

Can all my stations watch a DVD at the same time

Unfortunately no, only one machine can use the DVD capability at any given time.

Is it normal to see errors on startup and shutdown

Yes it is very normal, these errors are present because windows is not accustom to having multiple users log in to the same machine at the same time. Currently this error is not resolvable and must be overlooked
